

MOTOR VEHICLE CRASH NON-INJURY STANDING ORDER

USE STANDING ORDER ON CONTACTS GREATER THAN 18 YEARS OLD THAT PRESENT THE FOLLOWING:

- No subjective complaints of pain, illness or injury
- No obvious injuries
- Alert and oriented X4 (person, time, place event)

DO NOT USE STANDING ORDERS ON:

- Minors under the age of 18 unless parent or legal guardian meets inclusion criteria and:
 - Understands risks of refusal
 - Not impaired by drugs or alcohol
 - Are physically present on scene
- Patients with **ANY** drug or alcohol consumption
- Patients meeting Level 1 trauma criteria
- Patients with any reported loss of consciousness

IF CONTACT MEETS EXCLUSION CRITERIA AND WISHING TO REFUSE:

Contact Administrative Medical Direction

IF CONTRACT MEETS INCLUSION CRITERIA:

Documentation shall be in accordance with agency specific procedures for non-EMS documentation policies.

IF REFUSAL ACCEPTED BY MEDICAL DIRECTION:

Follow standard
SAEMS/AGENCY patient refusal
documentation procedures
