TELL ME MORE: EPIC is a public health initiative involving The University of Arizona, the Arizona Department of Health Services, and over 130 participating EMS agencies across the state of Arizona.

TBI patient data was collected from 2007 to 2015 on nearly 22,000 patients cared for by over 11,000 EMS providers. EPIC is the largest project of its kind ever accomplished.

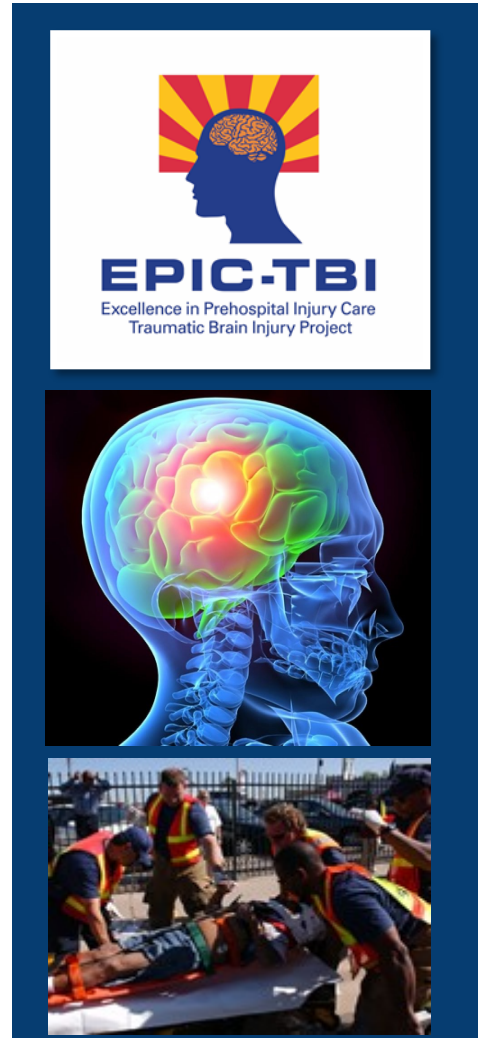
