

# GI COMPLAINT STANDING ORDER

## Initiate Immediate Supportive Care:

- Oxygen to maintain O<sub>2</sub> sat ≥ 94%
- Vital signs including FSBG and temperature as indicated
- Consider EKG and cardiac monitor

## INCLUSION

Nausea, vomiting, and/or abdominal pain

## ORDERS

### BLS Care:

- Initiate IV access if permitted (two 18-20 gauge if signs or symptoms of shock)

### ALS Care:

- Administer ondansetron 0.15 mg/kg (max dose 4mg) IV/IM . May repeat x 1
- Pain management per [Pain management SO](#)
- Consider assessment and treatment of ACS per [Chest Pain SO](#)

Signs of dehydration or hypovolemia

## ORDERS

- Administer NS/LR fluid bolus 20 ml/kg. May repeat x1 if indicated.
- Reassess after every 500 ml

### Special Note:

- Ondansetron IM in general is ineffective for motion sickness
- Ondansetron IM dosing onset time is 15 minutes with peak level 20–40 minutes
