**Air Medical/ Providers**- Nothing to report. No meeting, April Cancelled. Meeting next June 11th.

**American Red cross** – Mike- Responded to 7 fires in the last two months. Have shelter rodeo planned. Capacity is looking good for any responses needed this summer.

**Cochise Community College** – Advisory Board- Melissa- EMT skills testing on May 10<sup>th</sup>, we need help, please contact Eric Bailey if interested in helping. Testing in May. PMD 101 starts May 27<sup>th</sup>. We have a tutor available through the college to help students pass the first round. EMT class starts May 27<sup>th</sup> as well. Gus Cantu has joined the instructor team. 8 Medic students graduate in July, and all have jobs lined up. Accu placer is a national test that helps students identify where they are subjects for passing.

**CCEOC**- Dan D.- training, PIO class, IMC class cancelled, Active shooter/incident management class in June.

ADQ- two ED fire blankets went to Bisbee, two more coming and will decide where to place them.

Wildland season is here- ready set go program has no major changes. In the next few weeks, we will conduct a test tone through the county, it will only go to phones that are set up to receive test tones.

Small fire near Apache Nitrogen/ trucking terminals- working on dates for a site visit. ICS 300 and 400 just finished up.

Flyers are available for ready set go program- See Albert. I would like to see everyone utilize the link, the more that sign up, the more effective the program.

**Cochise County Public Health**- Nothing to report

**CCSO**- Bob- incident in Happy Valley, silver alert for an older lady, she was found safe and transported, no updates further.

**Communications Committee**- Bob- State has trunking system up and running and it will be operating this summer, need to look at current structure on VHF architecture.

Billy Seamans- what time frame for talk groups- in July, should have ability to add capacity. Currently we have 4 Channels in system. The upgrade will provide more capacity for the repeaters. We've asked the

county for 5 channels that will be available throughout the county. In the EMS realm, will work for the tac channels during an incident. These changes will help in making our scenes safer with dispatch being able to move over.

Ev- BPD meeting next wed- they broke their council and cannot utilize the patch. BPD received 3 of 9 vehicles. Outfitters did not entirely get the wiring right, but we were able to fix and get them on the road

**LEPC-** Dan- working on HAZMAT site visit for Apache fire. Tabletop at SVFD station 3 on May 22<sup>nd</sup>.

**SAEMS Council-** Matt- April 15<sup>th</sup>- SAEMS building a new site with additional features that expand on current site. The new site will be running soon. Hoping it will be accessible for the region. Financial discussion on budget- ADHS funding, Chuck Kramer scholarship has approx... \$25,000, it will sit until used. EMCT award- Michelle Robins from Fry Fire was selected for this award. Congratulations Michelle!!

**PDR-** Abuse and neglect protocol was approved and will be coming through. Manny announced all transport ventilators are now gone and the majority of those went to Cochise County. PIMA county is doing a beat the heat program for heat emergencies coming this summer. Manny has more vent circuits available if you need them. Get them before they expire. Chair for SAEMS is still up- Dr Gaither was the only nominee, the council wants more nominations to be sure a fair decision is made. Voting for the nominations will be coming out soon. NEMISIS 35 updates will be coming out. Make sure you are up to date. SWRTC (Trauma conference)- Will be held at Casino Del Sol- vote to do scholarship for conference. This will cover only the registration. Does not cover labs. Voted for 4 scholarships. Motion: Sam Foster Second: Lori Lewis. Applications need to be in by June 25<sup>th</sup>.
