Bisbee has 5 more vehicles coming, they will be upfitted with radios, lights, etc. before delivery. AZ rangers were given a quote for Kenwood/EF Johnson VP8000 radios. They are applying for a grant that another Arizona Company of the Rangers used to obtain radios. We should be using the same names for the channels on ALL radios to prevent confusion when being directed to go to a given channel.
