Air Medical/ Providers- Greg- Nothing to report, meeting was cancelled. Next meeting October 8th.

Chief Seamans- concerns on air ships being down due to weather, requesting a process for notification of when air ships are down. SEACOM should send out notifications, SEACOM currently does not get real time updates of when air ships are down.

There is delay in patient care and transport and work on clearing up communication between all involved should be done.

Alyssa - Diversion from CVMC is based on the Radiology department, mostly. It is in the works with the new CEO of CVMC to clean up the process, end date TBD.

Chief Seamans requesting that flight communicates with CVMC when they may be grounded/not available for launch.

American Red Cross- Mike- Responded to two fires in last month. Building team capacity in Cochise County. We will have a bigger presence in Cochise County soon.

Mike will give out a number to bypass the 800 automated number. That number is 833-583-3111.

Cochise Community College- Beth- 8 Paramedic students graduated in July. 7 passed NREMT-P so far. All EMTs finished their class, and all have passed their NREMT.

Reminder- Chuck Kramer scholarship for those that can be refunded a certain amount for their class that was paid out of pocket and passed successfully and that they stay within the SEAMS region.

CCEOC- Dan- Still working on county resolution policy- brushing up some items on that for completion. Working on Wildfire quick start guide. We have a contractor on board for the wildfire program. We have adopted the LEPC HAZMAT response plan.

Question- Should we do one grant with multiple agencies for the multi-meter sensor or individual? Dan will find out which is best on how to apply.

Chief Foster- recommends doing the grant as a group.

Dan will submit the grant in the next couple days. Cutoff date is Sep 1st

Cochise County Public Health- Kim- Two things: positive of West Nile Virus (WNV) in a pool of mosquitos in Douglas. A packet will be distributed soon to go over some safety and health tips. Severe symptoms can show in up to 50% of those who contract the virus.

Measles in Mojave County have risen. Rash that spreads from mouth to the rest of the body.

Hospitals have been made aware as well and kept up to date.

PDR- Alyssa- Pushed through the non-injured patient protocol. Some verbiages changed but not much. DNR form is under review through SEAMS.

SEACOM- Tammi Jo- 17 full-time members. Reposting position this week. Encouraging fire departments to do sit ins to gain understanding of what they do.

Chief Seamans- Operations committee meeting coming up- will be talking about tactical channels for surrounding departments, talk groups, talk groups to F channels, these will be used during major incidents. Talk groups on the trunk system. Best for coverage and availability. Moving away from 800 north and 800 South. Helicopter channels will still be used on the current channel, no changes there. The hope is to take the talk groups to use these channels for areas such as Tombstone and Bisbee that have geographical challenges and SEACOM will be able to hear us clearly. Looking to make it as a formal process going forward. No change to the G2 system except, going to add a critical alert tone for certain natures of calls, cardiac arrest, commercial fire, drownings, etc. Will present to Ops committee on the 5th. Go-live will be on the 8th, the Monday, after the 5th. More discussions to take place at the next Ops committee meeting.

Once SEACOM has more staff, they will host a LEO channel for departments other than CCSO.

Questions for CAP came up - Meeting will be held there next month.
